- PLEASE READ – DIGA ENTRY PROCEDURES –

The images MUST be in JPEG format, and must be submitted on CD-ROM. The image files and media will not be returned. The files must be in JPEG format. Your entry forms and fees must be in the same package.

Image file name: (How to name your JPEG image files) The DIGA has four (4) sections: A = Color General / Open, B = Color Creative / Altered Reality, C = Monochrome General / Open, D = Monochrome Creative / Altered Reality. The appropriate sections letter (A,B,C,or D) must be used as part of the electronic file name. Your surname and initial of your first name will be used at the first part of the file name as shown below: surname-X-####-YZ.jpg.

Surname is your family name. "X" is the first character(initial) in your given name. #### is the last four digits of your telephone number. "Y" is the sections letter (A, B, C, D) and "Z" is the image number (1-4) of the entry.

DO NOT USE YOUR TITLES FOR YOUR JPG IMAGE FILE NAMES!

Please fill out your paper DIGA entry form completely and include it in with you CD!

Entry file dimensions and size: The required maximum horizontal dimension is 1024 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 768 pixels! Smaller images are acceptable. If the images do not meet the file criteria the committee will try to resolve the problem for the benefit of the entrant. Please keep you compressed jpg images file size under 350KB. Larger file sizes may be rejected by the system we are using at this time. Fair warning!

Judging: Judging will be done by projecting images on a screen with an electronic projector at a resolution of 1024x768, set to 16.7 million colors. There will be four rounds of images in each section with 3 judges using scores of 0-3, with any image getting a 7 being in the show. All 9's will be HMs or receive a medal.

Report cards will be sent via email only and as an attachment, and the catalogue (with medal winning images, and additional images of merit and interest) will be on a CD and mailed to all the entrants.

Circuit Acceptance stickers will NOT be given for images accepted in the DIGA Circuit.

Every Division, in every show, will award one PSA Best of Show Medal. Also, in EVERY division of each DIGA show, there will be at least four additional (4) medals awarded by the Judges. Additional medals and awards will be given as the total entry numbers increase and the quality of images entered demand.

ALSO – H.M. Ribbons will be awarded by each exhibition at the discretion of the judges as to overall merit. An image may win only one award per show.

NOTE: Any entrant is eligible for any award offered by the judging panels!

2007 DIGA Photo Exhibitions in Georgia

Shows (all medal, award winners, and selected other images which represent the overall show) will be presented at APG, the Atrium and the Woodstock and Canton Libraries; Also the (camera clubs) Delta, Woodstock, Dixie Bells, Athens, IVAC, Rome, Images of Man, and the Parrin Groups. Selected images will be presented to at selected high schools in north Georgia as part of their art and journalism classes. All shows of the DIGA will be judged October 6 & 7, 2007

Any and all entries arriving late will NOT be returned, and will not be judged! The CD will be destroyed, or returned to you!

Reports for all judging of the DIGA shows will be emailed to the entrants by October 12, 2007.

The CD catalogue with the listing of all entrants accepted images and with the medal winning photos will be mailed by December 15th, 2007.

At least 12 shows of all the accepted DIGA images will be presented between October the 15th and the end of the year. Later shows may be presented if requested via PowerPoint from DVD.

EARLY BIRD SPECIAL RATES

The 2007 DIGA Exhibition Circuit -- CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The 2007 Digital Georgia Exhibition Circuit is ONLY for the P.S.A. E.I.D. approved division.

Split Entries are NOT acceptable!

1. The DIGA (the Digital Georgia Photo Circuit, our first digital exhibition, which we hope will be an annual circuit as is the 15th GASO, and the 7th NORGA) is an exhibition which follows the procedures of the PSA and is open to everyone around the world – However an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring group, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to the exhibitions rules and conditions! Entry implies the acceptance of those conditions. Accepted images will be listed in the Photographic Society of America’s Who’s Who listings and are acceptable for the Star Ratings of the PSA. 2. One entry is up to 4 images in any division. 3. You must indicate which section you are entering on the submitted entry forms which must include the correct fees. All checks must be made out to **ROBERT GINN**. 4. Multiple entries from different people are acceptable, and are encouraged, in one mailed package. 5. The right to reproduce your image is assumed to be granted. 6. The original exposure must be made by the exhibitor listed as the entrant for that images. 7. All files must bear the maker’s name and entry number as listed on the DIGA entry form. 8. The titles will be NOT be read. 9. The entrant must be the owner and holder of all rights to the images submitted and entered in the DIGA. 10. Entry of images is not limited to images created and or modified digitally. (Scanned images fitting the electronic file requirements are acceptable and encouraged!) 11. Images must be submitted by removable disk media, i.e. CD-ROM or DVD. 12. The entry forms and fees must be included with the media containing the entry. 13. The media must ONLY contain the files in JPEG of the entered images – Nothing else! 14. The files must not be “zipped.” 15. By virtue of submitting an entry the entrant certifies the work as his own and permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication on a CD-ROM catalog, on a internet website and to display the media in related exhibitions. The Exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright by the entrant. Images previously accepted in the DIGA Exhibition Circuit may not be re-entered regardless of its title. (Images entered in past years GASO and NORGA Exhibition Circuits are all acceptable in this first years show!)

PLEASE NOTE: As this is our first year we choose **not to use email attachments** for entry – This will change in the future as we “get the system down” - - Remember this is a circuit with 6 times the possibilities to have a glitch in our way of doing it. Feel free (and we hope you will) to include a letter in with your entries with your suggestions on how we can do it better next year – and there well be a next year in our new DIGA digital circuit here in Georgia! Please help us with your suggestions for the future show circuits!
